### **ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE SA COUNCIL FOR SOCIAL SERVICE PROFESSIONS (SACSSP) AND THE PROFESSIONAL BOARD FOR SOCIAL WORK (PBSW)**

As you are aware, the Council is presently conducting the processes of electing the members of the third SA Council for Social Service Professions and the second Professional Board for Social Work. This is an historic occasion and therefore important that as many social workers as possible participate by bringing out their votes. Elections will be held from **01 February 2010 to 03 March 2010** and shall take place by closed ballot.

Ballot papers were mailed to all registered social workers. The closing time and date for the return of all ballots are **16H00 on 03 March 2010. No late ballot papers will be accepted.**
