NOTICE TO: ALL CHILD AND YOUTH CARE WORK TRAINING PROVIDERS

The Professional Board for Child and Youth Care Work under the auspices of the South African Council for Social Service Professions is finalizing the process leading to the implementation of the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) policy. In order to effectively implement this policy, the Professional Board resolved to test the user-friendliness of the administrative systems relating to this policy. All those who are interested in having their training-; staff development-; seminar-, or conference material that was presented during the year 2019 to June 2020 to be assessed for CPD points, must do so with immediate effect. Such providers must note that:

- a) Once the trial period is complete and the policy is fully operational, no evaluation of material will be done retrospectively;
- b) All applications for CPD accreditation that meet the requirements or have all supporting documentation will be assessed on a first come first served principle;
- c) All CPD assessments will be conducted according to the CPD policy.
- d) Submission of material to be assessed must be well ahead of the planned event to avoid undue pressure on the CPD adjudication panels.
- e) The CPD policy, application form and other guiding documents are available on the SACSSP website.
