## RENEW YOUR LICENSE TO PRACTICE

**Happy New Year!** Our office reopened on 4 January 2021 with some security restrictions for visitors. It is encouraging to see that registrants are paying their annual fees for 2021/22. You have 73 days left to pay your 2021/22 annual fees. Annual fees are payable to Council by 1 January 2021 until **31 March 2021** to remain registered. Failure to pay by 31 March 2021 will result in deregistration and you will incur additional costs to the original fee payable to restore your name on the Register. *General Notice 1 of 2021* regarding annual fees for 2021/2022 was issued on 14 January 2021, click on the link below for a full notice.
