SACSSP offices are closed until 12 July 2021 following confirmed COVID-19 positive cases amongst staff. The offices were deep cleansed whilst staff are in isolation.

Services are currently offered remotely until 12th July 2021 when a blended approach will continue where staff will be working on rotational shifts. Only courier companies fetching documents on behalf of practitioners will be allowed on site, under strict conditions. No members of the sector will be allowed to visit the office whilst under the alert level 4. During this period, emailed registration applications must be accompanied by scanned certified supporting documents not older than three (3) months.

The Registrations Division has since 25 June 2021 to 2 July 2021 processed and registered 35 social workers, 3 student social workers, 3 social auxiliary workers, 43 student social auxiliary workers, 15 child and youth care workers at auxiliary level and 1 child and youth care worker at professional level. During the same period the names of 2 social workers were restored to the Register, whilst 22 social workers were removed from the Register (deregistered) in terms of section 20 of the Social Service Professions Act 110 of 1978. The Division also issued 48 status of registration reports, responded to 406 verification of registration status requests from employers and completed 21 verifications of international qualifications in terms of section 17 D of the Social Service Professions Act.
