1. All registered social workers, social auxiliary workers, child and youth care workers and auxiliary child and youth care workers,
2. Training institutions providing qualifications in social work, social auxiliary work, child and youth care work and auxiliary child and youth care work; and
3. Employers of social service professionals

### REMINDER: PAYMENT OF ANNUAL FEES FOR THE 2024/2025 FINANCIAL YEAR

1. Reference is made to the General Notices 5 and 9 of 2023 pertaining to the annual fees for 2024/25 financial year payable by social service professionals, published on 24 July 2023 and 24 November 2023 respectively.
2. The South African Council for Social Service Professions (SACSSP) would like to appreciate all social service professionals who have already paid their annual fees for 2024/2025 financial year by the due date of 01 January 2024.
3. This General Notice serves as a reminder to social service professionals who are still to pay, to kindly do so within 90 days counting from 02 January 2024, in order to avoid their names being removed from the register in terms of section 20(1)(d) of the Social Service Professions Act, (110 of 1978).
4. The Regulations on *fees payable by social workers, child and youth care workers, social auxiliary workers, auxiliary child and youth care workers, student social worker and student child and youth care worker* can be downloaded [here](#). All registered social service professionals are encouraged to study these Regulations thoroughly.
5. **The annual fees for 2024/25 financial year per professional category is as follows;**

<b>Professional category</b>	<b>Annual fee</b>
<i>Social workers</i>	<i>R500.00</i>
<i>Social auxiliary workers</i>	<i>R250.00</i>
<i>Child and youth care workers</i>	<i>R500.00</i>
<i>Auxiliary child and youth care workers</i>	<i>R250.00</i>
<i>Specialities in social work</i>	<i>R500.00</i>

- 5.1. Annual fees payable to the SACSSP need to be deposited into the SACSSP's bank account with a correct reference number (see paragraphs below).

5.1.1 All payments must have the correct *Deposit Reference Number* as this is the only way in which the SACSSP can identify a payment made in the bank account. The SACSSP is not liable nor responsible for payments that are made without an identifiable and correct *Deposit Reference Number*.

## **5.2 Deposit Reference Numbers**

### **5.2.1 For annual fees**

- 5.2.1.1 For the payment of annual fees by social service professionals already registered with the SACSSP should use their SACSSP registration number as a Deposit Reference Number:
- (a) For social workers their SACSSP registration number starting with 10-;
  - (b) For social auxiliary workers their SACSSP registration number starting with 50-;
  - (c) For child and youth care work (professional category) their SACSSP registration number starting with 70-; and
  - (d) For auxiliary child and youth care workers their SACSSP registration number starting with 90-;
- 5.2.1.2 Always keep a copy of your proof of payment for your own records.
- 5.2.1.3 Social service professionals who have paid the annual fee will receive their practice cards through email as soon as the payment is processed. Kindly remember to always check your spam/junk email in the event you have not received an emailed practice card.
