AUTHORISED SIGNATURES FOR SACSSP PRACTICE CARDS

1. The President of the South African Council for Social Service Professions (SACSSP) herewith informs all social service professionals (social workers, social auxiliary workers, child and youth care workers and auxiliary child and youth care workers) of the updated authorised signatory to sign/execute all the documents pertaining to the Registers kept in terms of section 19 of the Social Service Professions Act 110 of 1978.
2. Kindly note that the *Practice Cards* issued from 01 October 2023 to 11 February 2024 for the 2024/2025 financial year under the name and signature of the former Registrar will be reissued under the current authorised signature of the Acting Registrar, Mr Hitler Sekhitla.
 - 2.1 Noting the unresolved and historical challenges with the South African Post Office of undelivered mail, the SACSSP decided to email *Practice Cards* to registrants. Notwithstanding, printed *Practice Cards* can be made available upon request. In this regard:
 - 2.1.1 Please notify the SACSSP's Secretariat in writing to request a printed *Practice Card*, with a clear indication of your SACSSP registration number and where it should be mailed to or whether it will be collected at the SACSSP's office in Pretoria. In the case of a request for it to be mailed by post, please be sure that you do receive postal mail on a regular basis.
 - 2.1.2 Social service professionals to organise themselves within their workplace or practice settings if several persons wish to have printed *Practice Cards* and send in a consolidated request. In such case, please delegate one of their colleagues to collect the *Practice Cards* from the SACSSP's Office or to whom it should be mailed. Social service in private practice to liaise with the office for the printing and distribution of *Practice Cards*.
 - 2.1.3 If you opt to collect *Practice Card* from the SACSSP's Office, you will be informed by email when it is ready. Kindly do not visit the office before you have received confirmation that it is ready.
